



What Does NOT Count



DRIVING

Hours spent driving someone to a doctor's appointment, therapy, hospital, or other places in the community cannot be counted. These neighborly favors & assistance have great value, however we cannot count them as an RSVP volunteer hour.

POLITICAL ACTIVITY

We cannot count hours spent in political efforts. These also are important activities & we encourage your participation, but you cannot report a volunteer hour that persuades someone to vote, to vote for a particular person, or even the hours spent as a precinct worker during an election.

RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

We cannot count hours spent in actual religious instruction. Other activities regarding church fellowship & support can be counted—mentoring breakfasts, putting out flowers, cleaning the church or mowing the church lawn, knitting, sewing quilts, being on a church board & other support can be counted! It's *convincing* or *persuading* activities that cannot be counted.

PAYMENT FOR VOLUNTEERING

Volunteers cannot be paid for volunteer services—if they are, the hours cannot be counted.

Occasionally there is some confusion about what can be counted for an RSVP volunteer hour.

Here are some guidelines.

If you ever have a question, do one of two things—or both!

- Call us with your question—947-8462
- Send the information in on your time sheet and the time recorder can make the determination as to whether the volunteer hour in question can be counted.
